


When Mitel Connect is installed, the log in screen will appear.

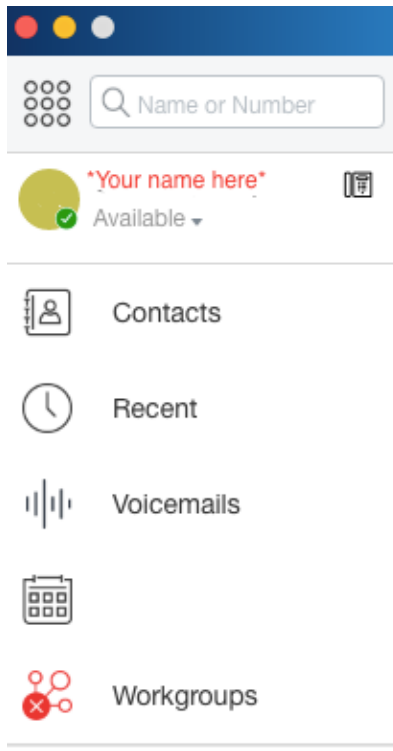

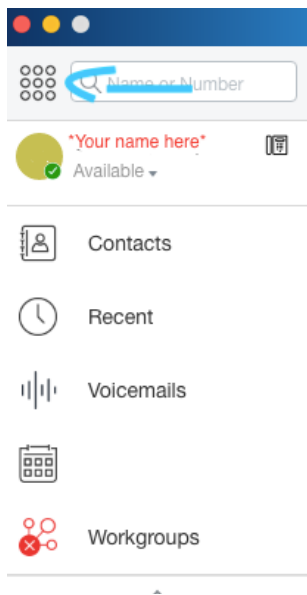
They will be the same as your Brentwood email credentials. You may use either the username only or the full email if you would like.
